Reading

Since Patriot Day is on Monday, we will focus most of our read alouds and activities around September 11th.

We will also begin working in small groups to focus more on each child's needs.

****Remember to read with your child each night!**

Word Work

Each week we will focus on a group of words based on spelling/phonics rules. We will study several words that follow the "rule" throughout the week. On Friday, we will do a "spelling assessment" to determine if your child can apply the "rule."

We want our students to learn the rules for spelling words rather than memorize a set list of 10 words.

This week we will focus on words with short "o" and long "o."

The following are a few examples of words we will be studying this week.

Examples: rock, home, joke, nose, job, those, stove, hose, etc.

Writing

We will continue to build our "seed notebooks" and focus on writing complete sentences. We will begin to learn about and write personal narratives.
