

## Frederick James Overton, II Memorial Scholarship

The Fred Overton Memorial Scholarship will financially assist a high school student in higher pursuit of education in the medical profession. This award supports a student who excels academically, is a leader among their peers, and is making a positive impact on the community.

### **Eligibility**

- Currently a high school senior planning to attend college in the medical field
- Entering an accredited undergraduate institution full time (at least 12 hours)
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Be involved in a balance of community, school and work activities
- Pursue goals and aspirations with integrity, resolution, self-discipline and judgment

### **Selection Criteria – Awardees will be selected based on the following criteria:**

1. Essay questions (2)
2. Grade Point Average (GPA)
3. Leadership
4. Community Involvement

### **How to Apply:**

1. **Complete Application.** You may complete the application available from your high school counselor.
2. **Transcript.** You must submit a copy of your most recent **OFFICIAL** high school transcript with your application. It must go up to and include the spring quarter/semester of your Junior year of high school.
3. **References.** You are required to have two reference forms submitted from individuals who know you and are familiar with your community service and leadership activities. A teacher, counselor, work supervisor, community service leader, or any other adult familiar with you can serve as a reference. Recommendations from relatives will not be accepted.
4. **Submit Your Application.** The deadline to submit your application is midnight of May 1, 2013. Your application must be turned in to Ms. Hopke, High School Counselor.
