1) AIS Scholarships - \$10,000 - 35 Awards (Deadline: February 15, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Enrolled in a university, college, junior college or technical school
- B) One-Quarter (1/4) enrolled member of a Federally Recognized Native American Tribe

2) Elks National Foundation Scholarship - \$4,000 - 250 Awards (Deadline: February 3, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) The student must complete and submit the ONLINE application. The 2017 Legacy Awards application deadline is due online by 12:00 p.m. (noon) Central Time on Friday, February 3, 2017.
- B) Upon receipt of the application, the applicant will receive a notification that the application was received. Winners will be announced in late April 2017.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

4) 2017 Scholarship Points Awards - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) At least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) A legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

5) Shred Paper to Stand Against Bullying - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) No minimum GPA or essay required. This \$5,000 easy scholarship is open to people ages 13 to 25. You must also live in the U.S. or have U.S citizenship.

6) John and Muriel Landis Scholarships - \$1,000 - 9 Awards (Deadline: February 1, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.
